

MOU/Expression of Interest

This Memorandum of Understanding is being executed on 22.03.2019 between M/s ATS InfoTech Pvt.Ltd, Microsoft-AEP(Authorized Education Partner)having its registered officeatL-107, LajpatNagar-II, NewDelhi 110024 and represented by Mr.Sandeep Giyyan Jethani (Director Operations) hence for purpose of MOU known as 'Delivery Partner' and Sri Krishna Institute of Technology, Bengaluru represented by Dr.A. Manjunath (Principal), hence for purpose of MOU known as 'Resource Partner'.

1. Delivery Partner would be offering International Certifications to the interested students from different vendors@ academic discounted price and those students whovoluntarily pay the exam fees would be getting bundled training free of cost mapped to the certifications.
2. This contract in no way creates any financial binding nor does it imply that 'resource partner' has committed to provide any fixed number of student's registrations per year for the certification exams /bundled workshops, the only commitment from their end is to provide platform to address students / seminar to educate and motivate them about the various certifications and subsequent permission for registering the students who are voluntarily interested for the same.
3. 1st 50 students of each department will be getting exam insurance under which if the student fails, he/she would have to just pay a nominal cost towards the 2nd attempt and for exam proctoring instead of paying the entire amount again.
4. Delivery Partner would bundle a 'free of charge'faculty development Program once a year for the faculty members of the resource partner.
5. Delivery Partner would also sponsor certification vouchers for faculty members equivalent to 10% of the total students enrolled in academic year.
6. Delivery partner would also be bundling free subscription access for 'mentorbuddy.com'f or assessment and post assessment support mapped for both university curriculum and for aptitude test prep.
7. Students would be registering directly for the certification exam by making payment with M/s ATS Infotech Pvt ltd or to SPOC appointed by the resource partner,either online or offline by chq/cash/DD, proper receipts would be issued for the same. In case if the resource partner collects the payments, the same would have to be transferred to delivery partner max within 7 days, as exam vouchers can only be registered once payment is made.Students would be receiving a conformation mail of their voucher being booked and entitlement to free training/workshop, once they register either online or offline.
8. The fee charged is against Microsoft /other vendor Certification exam and all other services like training are complimentary / bundled free and cannot be linked anywhere with the release of payment to delivery partner(in case if the certification fees is collected by resource partner).



9. Student would be receiving their transcript and certificates for the exam directly in their account in e-format, from the specific vendor like Microsoft /Oracle/Certiport etc. post successfully clearing the exam.
10. Resource Partner would be Provided 15% of the total number of students enrolled as 'Resource Utilization Fees' against use of infrastructure and other resources for the bundled free training.
11. Resource Partner would provide necessary infrastructure within college, like lab's with Computers, LCD Projector's, internet etc. for the execution of the free training and conducting the Certification Exam.
12. Resource partner would allocate time slot either on weekends/holidays /regular slot for min 6-8hrs or as per mutual consent with delivery partner for execution of FREE training in their campus.
13. The duration of the training may increase as per the level of participants and shall not be linked with the release of payments.
14. The tenure of the contract would be for a period of three years i.e. from 22.03.2019 to 22.03.2021, same cannot be terminated before a period of one year from the date of signing of the MOU.
15. Prices of the certification are subject to yearly review and revision as per the policy of the Certification vendor and other state and govt taxes as and when applicable by the Govt of India. However a proper communication would be provided, whenever there is impact on the same.
16. "Resource Partner "cannot hire or take services from any current full time /part time, ex-employee of the Delivery Partner either directly or indirectly for any fulltime or part time assignment for minimum period of one year from the date of expiry of contract.
17. "Resource Partner "must follow from time to time rules/regulation & operational protocols laid down by Microsoft/Certiport other international vendors for their respective certification.
18. In case of any dispute ,or difference whatsoever arising between the parties out of or relating to the construction, meaning, scope, operation or effect of this contract or the validity or the breach there of shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitration of the Indian Council of Arbitration and the award made in pursuance there of shall be binding on the parties, however the court of jurisdiction would be Bengaluru.
19. The clause is intended to be legally binding and the parties agree and acknowledge that both the terms of MOU and the discussion relating to the collaborative activity are confidential and neither party will disclose them without the prior written consent of the other party.
20. Resource Partner would issue a letter of completion upon successful completion of the certification and bundled training program.



21. Minimum batch size to run a free training/workshop bundled with Certification will be 50 students however in case the numbers are different, than the decision on the same would be as per mutual consent.

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made on 26th October 2016 ("Effective Date"), by and between

1. Sri Krishna Institute of Technology, a [trust/company], having its office at Hesaraghatta Main Road, Bengaluru and represented by its Authorized Signatory, Dr. A. Manjunatha (hereinafter referred to as "Institute"); and
2. Hed Experts Private Limited, a company incorporated under the laws of India, having its registered office at 11, Commissariat Road, Opp. Ashok Nagar Police Station, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560025, India, and represented by its Authorized Signatory, Mr. Aniruddha Kannal (hereinafter referred to as "Company") of the other part.

(The Institute and the Company are referred to individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties")

The objective of this partnership is the development of an academia-industry consortium for creation of a collaborative learning community.

Recitals

1. The Institute is an educational institution providing educational and related facilities to students across various learning streams and disciplines. The Company owns and provides a learning platform called "xcelerator", which amongst others, connects students and faculty across educational institutions to various companies and projects for skill development and enhancement ("Platform").
2. The Institute and the Company are desirous of collaborating with each other to enable the students of the Institute to access and utilize the Platform, on the broad terms and conditions mentioned herein.

Scope of the Partnership

1. The Company shall provide access to the Platform to all participating students from the Institute, based on the terms and conditions provided in the Platform. The Company shall offer skill aligned projects and educational content under the Platform, and provide an opportunity to the participating students to interact with corporates, institutes as well as with each other to enhance their skills and education.
2. Company will provide the following facilities to the Institute and to the participating students and staff of the Institute:
 - a. Access to the Platform, industry partners, projects, and learning content
 - b. Effective functioning of the Platform;

- c. Necessary personnel to control and co-ordinate the activities of the Platform and its user interface;
 - d. Address the concerns and grievances of the Institute, if any, relating to the functioning of the Platform within mutually agreeable timelines;
 - e. The Company shall also provide any other facilities as may be agreed between the Company and the Institute from time to time.
3. The Institute has agreed to co-operate with the Company in the following manner, to facilitate the use of the Platform by its students:
 - a. Access to the Company to interact and engage with the students of the Institute, including through personal interactions, counselling and supply of online and offline material;
 - b. Encourage the students and staff to access and engage in the Platform; and raise awareness regarding the purpose and utility of the Platform;
 - c. Designate a representative to control and co-ordinate the activities with the Company;
 - d. Facilitate organization, support and follow-up of visits of the Company's representatives to the Institute;
4. The Company and the Institute may also organize and conduct workshops, seminars and conferences in the Institute regarding the Platform on mutually agreeable terms and topics.

Confidentiality and Intellectual Property Rights

1. The Company is the sole and exclusive owner of the intellectual property, brand name, logos, software, content, information and materials relating to the Platform, and has all the rights and interest relating to ownership and use of the Platform. The Institute acknowledges that the Company shall also have all the rights and interest in the content arising from the access and use of the Platform.
2. The Institute and Company are free to publicly share/publish/make announcements about this partnership/engagement.
3. Rights to content created with a commercial intent will be owned jointly by the creator and the Company. Terms for such an arrangement will be decided independent of this MOU.

Payments

1. There is no monetary consideration envisaged under this MOU.
2. The Company may charge certain costs and fees to the participating students with respect to certain facilities being provided by the Company under the Platform (e.g. project evaluations, industry certifications, virtual lab subscriptions, electronic kits, etc.). However, the Company will ensure that the participating students and the Institute are well informed of the requirements to pay for such facilities.

Representations

1. Each of the Parties represents and warrants that they have full authority to execute and perform their obligations under this MOU; and that the executed MOU would constitute a valid obligation of the Parties.
2. The Platform is a channel for providing value addition to the education and skills of the students, and the Parties acknowledge that it should not be construed as a channel which guarantees an internship or job placement.

3. The Parties will keep each other indemnified from any and all losses, liabilities, claims, costs and expenses incurred by an affected Party on account of breach of any Party's representations and warranties or breach of any undertakings or obligations under this MOU.

Terms


1. This MOU shall remain in force for a valid period of 3 years from the Effective Date. It may be terminated at any time by either Party with 3 months' notice to the other Party in writing.
2. The Parties will continue to abide by the provisions relating to 'Confidentiality', 'Indemnification', 'Platform Rights' notwithstanding any termination of this MOU.

Miscellaneous

1. This MOU constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties and supersedes any prior oral or written contract or any other communications, and may not be modified except by a written amendment signed by the authorized representatives of the Parties.
2. All notices, requests and communications shall be deemed to have been received by either Party on being sent to the address as stated in this MoU, including transmission by e-mail to the authorized signatory of the Parties.
3. The relationship between the Company and the Institute under this MOU is that of independent transacting parties. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to constitute the Parties as principal and agent, employer and employee, partners, or otherwise as participants in a joint undertaking.


